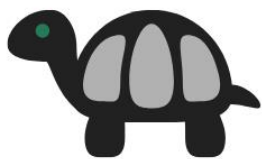

Study Spanish in Galapagos Islands

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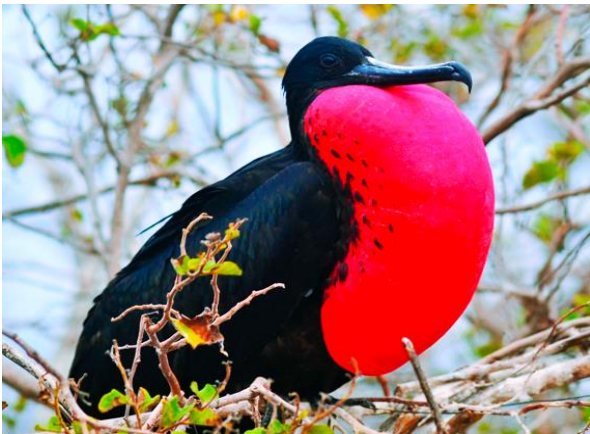


Live an incredible week studying Spanish in the enchanted islands

Surely you have heard of the theory of the evolution of species by natural selection developed by Charles Darwin. Basically what he tells us is that species evolve according to the environment in which they are and that only those that manage to adapt better are those that survive.

On his trip to the Galapagos Islands, Darwin discovered that on each island of the archipelago the turtles had different physical characteristics according to the climate or the type of ground on the island, this was the basis of the theory of evolution by natural selection.

The Galapagos Islands have volcanic origin and are located 1000 km offshore of Ecuador, also are one of the biggest tourist and scientific attractions of Ecuador. The islands were declared a Natural World Heritage Site in 1978.



Our program offers you the opportunity to visit the two most important islands in the archipelago (Santa Cruz and Isabela). On each of the islands there are activities that you do every day. For example, in Santa Cruz we are going to visit Tortuga Bay beach, a place that is considered among the 10 most beautiful beaches in the world.

The tortuga Bay trail has an approximate length of 2.5 km and the walking time is 50 minutes, here you can find a type of unique cactus in the Galapagos Islands, also sea turtles, iguanas and flamingos.



Another interesting place that we will visit in Santa Cruz is the El Chato Reserve. In this place you can observe the turtles in their natural habitat, you can also observe owls and Darwin's finches.



Finally, in Santa Cruz we will visit the Charles Darwin scientific station, in this place there is a museum with information on the main species of the archipelago and the history of Charles Darwin. The Scientific Station is essential to provide scientific knowledge and technical advice to the Government of Ecuador to ensure the conservation of Galapagos.



On Isabela Island we will visit the Sierra Negra Volcano, the highest of the Galapagos Islands and one of those with the largest crater in the world.



Another of the tourist attractions of Isabela Island are the tintoreras, it is a small rocky islet, which remains in its natural state and additionally has a small group of sea lions, marine iguanas and birds that stay on the rocks to rest. Las tintoreras is the ideal place to practice snorkeling and observe the marine life of the island.



The hostel where you will stay has a private bathroom, WiFi connection, private room, dining room and cafeteria.
